ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Yellow Fever Vaccine:

Please note that you are required to have an up-to-date yellow fever vaccine to travel in Uganda. You can arrange this in your home country and bring proof, or you can have the vaccine done in the airport upon arrival to Uganda for around US\$40. Rules and restrictions are always changing, so please make sure to do your own research for vaccines and visas before arriving in Uganda.

Volunteering project:

Regarding the main volunteer project activity, we reserve the right to change or cancel it. Due to unforeseen circumstances and the changing needs of our partners and the communities they serve, sometimes the projects do change. For example our partner may fail to acquire authorization in time, from the government to build a water well in a specific location. In the case that this happens, the project will be replaced with another one, either from the same partner or a different partner.

Itinerary

Day 1: Entebbe, Uganda

Arrival, pick-up and check-in (B)

You will be picked up by our guide and transferred to a hotel in Kampala for the night.

Day 2: Entebbe, Uganda

Walking tour of the city of Kampala and cultural concert (B)

We will start off our day with a walking tour of the city of Kampala. This immersive experience gets you up-close and personal with the city's sights and sounds. We will walk on the main street where Idi Amin famously evicted Asians out of their shops, then slope down town to heart of the city and visit sites like the taxi park and Owino market. We will finish the tour in time for lunch. Later that evening we will attend a cultural concert at the Ndere Arts Centre and we will get to discover many of the traditions that constitute of Uganda's tribes and culture.

Day 3-5: Entebbe - Jinja, Uganda

Transfer to the volunteer placement in Jinja (B/L)

We will head to Jinja, a town two hours east of Kampala on the northern shores of Lake Victoria and also home to the source of the Nile. These next two days will be spent volunteering with our partner programs in the education sector. We will be involved in renovation works of class rooms and also setting up extra-curricular activities for the local kids.

Day 6: Jinja - Murchison National Park, Uganda

Transfer to Murchison Falls National Park and game drive (B/L/D)

Set off early the next day, 5 hours North of Kampala to Murchison Falls national park for your Safari adventure. You will return in time for lunch. After lunch you will take a game drive to explore the various African wildlife found in the park.

Day 7: Jinja - Murchison National Park, Uganda

Game drive and boat tour on the Nile (B/L/D)

Get up before sunrise and take a shot at another game driving experience. Early morning game drives offer the best time to encounter wildlife active in the wild. In the afternoon, you will take a boat tour on the Nile and get up-close to countless schools of hippos and crocodiles.

Day 8: Murchison National Park - Kampala, Uganda

Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary and transfer back to Kampala (B)

After this magnificent experience head back south towards Kampala. You will make a stop at Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary a private ranch working to preserve and restore the Rhino population in Uganda. It's a great place to learn about the importance and benefits of conservation. You will go Rhino tracking and after that head back to Kampala for your evening flight out of the country.
